



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County on the Warriors run below the forks joining John Sprögel Surveyed on the 12th day of September A.D. 1835 by virtue of an order dated the 3d day of April 1769. No. 1028. granted to John Ludwig Sprögel Containing Two hundred and eighty eight acres & eighty seven perches and the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c.

Note, the same tract of land was Surveyed on the day of A.D. 1769 for Robt. Iswell in pursuance of his appl. dated 3d April 1769. No. ¹⁵⁵¹ and is now claimed and occupied by the Heirs of John Hower in right of Robert Iswell.
