



Situate in Buffalo township Union [late Berks] County, surveyed the 22^d day of October 1832 by virtue of an order granted to Sarah Simpson dated the 3^d day of April 1769. No. 1073. Containing two hundred & thirty three acres & 59 ps. with the usual allowance of six per ct.
