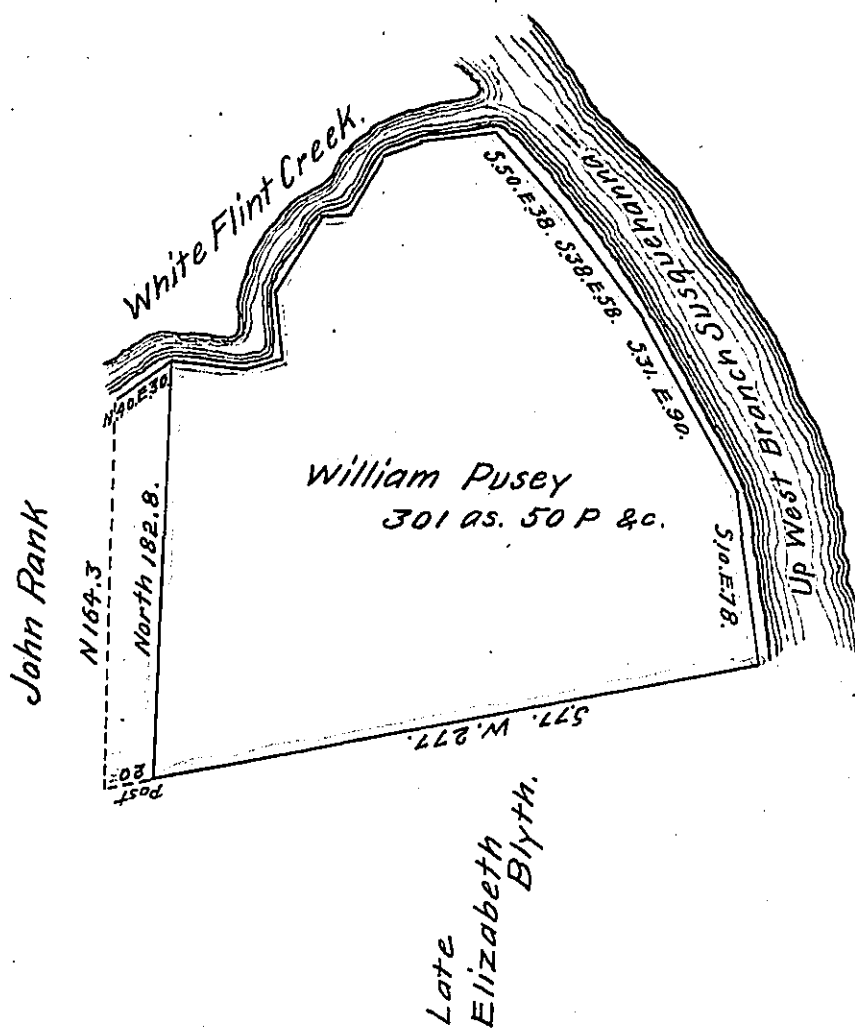

Situate below and joining the mouth of White Flint Creek in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 7th. of June 1837 by virtue of an order granted to William Pusey, dated 3d. of April 1769. No. 1557. containing three hundred & one acre & fifty perches with the usual allowance &c. and is represented by the green lines.

Note. the same land interferes & is included in a survey made the 18th. day of February 1769 for Margaret Blyth in pursuance of her order dated 3d. April 1769. No. 1025. Now owned by the heirs of Dr. Gillfelin. Dec'd & others in right of the said Margaret Blyth & is represented by the blue lines.
