



Situate in Turbut Township, Northumberland County, on the head of the E. branch of Delaware Run upon the East side of said branch, Surveyed the 24th. day of September 1835 by virtue of an Order dated the 3rd. day of April, 1769. No. 1461. granted to John Wiggins, Containing two Hundred and eighty three acres and One hundred & twenty six perches & the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent &c.
 Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 29th. day of June 1769. for Thomas Kilcrest in pursuance of his Order No. 946. dated the 3rd. day of April, 1769. and is now owned and Occupied by Mongo Reed's heirs, in right of said Thomas Kilcrest.
