



In pursuance of an Application granted to Samuel Taylor No. 1373 dated April, 1769. Surveyed on the 20th. of January 1829, the above described tract of land containing three hundred and five acres twenty three perches and the allowance proportioned at Six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate on the South side of Conemaugh river in Fairfield Township Westmoreland County Pen.:-

The above land was warranted to James Brady bearing date of February 1, 1787. John Cummings land was all in the name of Charles Cummings, and the river was erroneously called Kiskiminetas but that is no wonder as the Kiskiminetas is nothing but the Conemaugh except the addition of Loy creek from thence downward it is called Kiskiminetas and he must have supposed it bore the same name further up.
