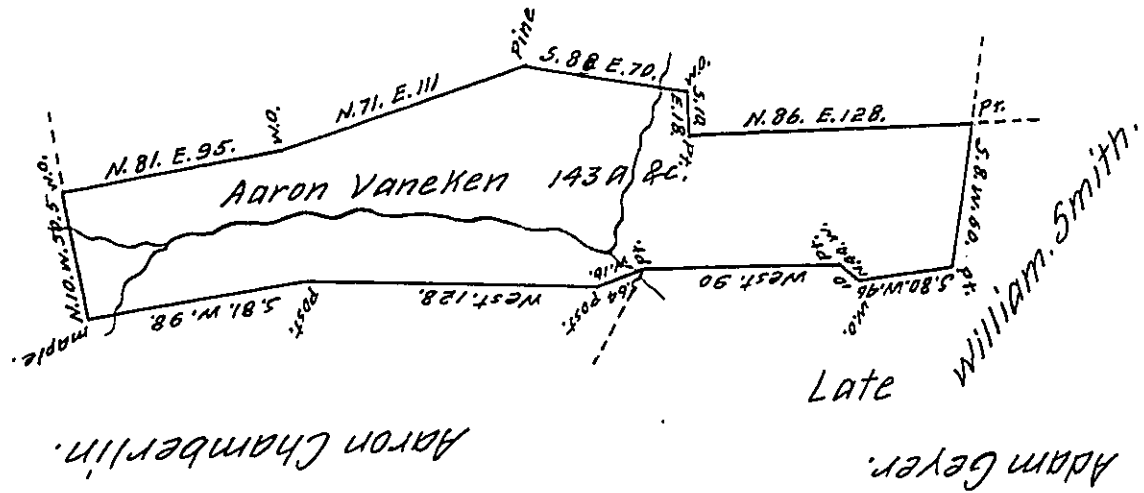


Late John Brandon.
