Situate in Redstone township Fayette County and now returned on S^d Location by virtue of a Contract with the Board of Property. the land wasn't first Surveyed to the dotted lines but on a resurvey, took in a small vacancy by Broshear or Fulton the land is owned by William Colvin Sett^r on the premises Was Surveyed to Sniveley 23^d Nov 1770 on S^d location, and is said to have been patented to William Colvin May 1829.
