



Situate in Buffalo township, Union County, Surveyed the 5th day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order of Survey Granted to John Meyer dated the 3d. of April, 1769. No. 1215 Containing two Hundred & twenty Six Acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 21st. of June 1771 for Philip Ewig in pursuance of his order dated 23d. day of August 1769. No. 3746 and now owned & by Alexander Graham & others in right of the said Philip Ewig.
