



*Situate on Buffalo Creek about four Miles above the Mouth in Kelly township, Union County. Surveyed the 28th. of July 1835. by virtue of an order dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 1249. Granted to George Diggs containing two Hundred & ninety four Acres & fifty perches &c. & is represented by the black lines.*

*Note. The same interferes & is included in two Surveys made the 9th August, 1769. which were allotted to Capt. Kerns & Lieut McCallister in pursuance of a warrant dated 7th. March 1769. The Dotted line represents Lieut. McCallister & is now owned by Thomas Howard in right of the said Kerns & McCallister.*
