



Situate in Kelly township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 6th day of March 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to Joseph Dobson dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. 635 Containing three hundred & six Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 17th day of March 1769 for Col. Turbut Francis being part of his Allotment which fell to him on the Division of a tract of 1105 Acres. Surveyed for the Officers of Col. Turbut Francis Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 9th day of March 1769. And now Owned & Occupied by David Lynn, John Lynn & Thomas Howard in right of the said Col. Francis.
