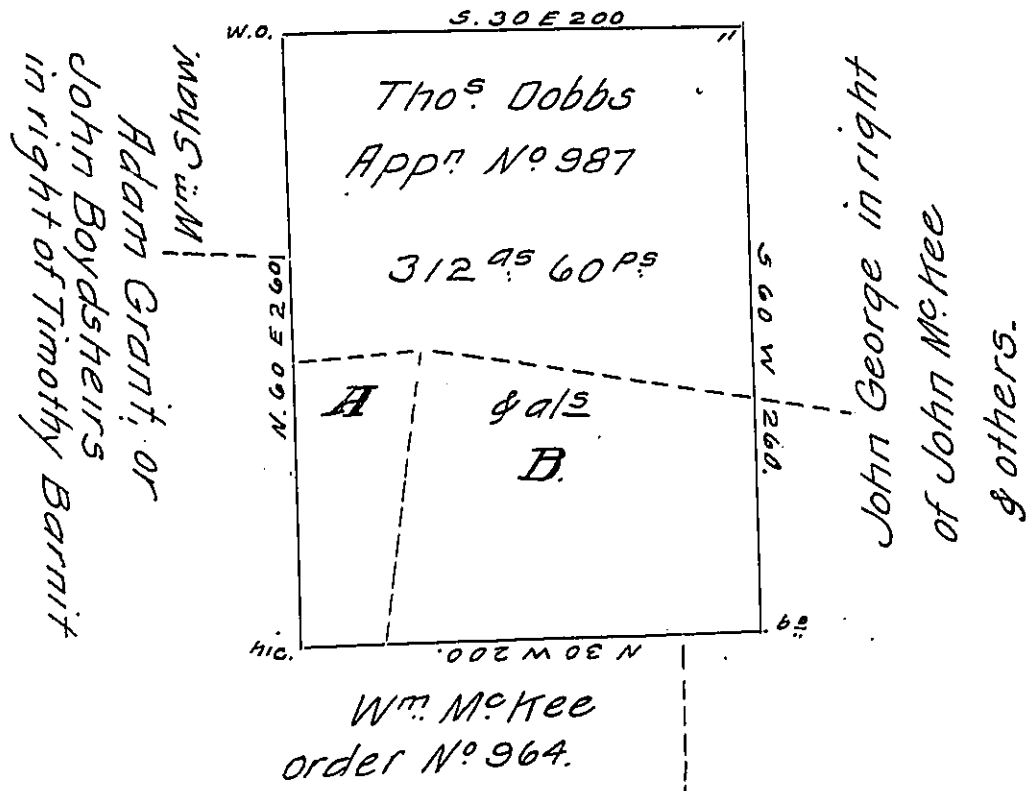


Eli Powell & Williamson
