The dotted lines represent part of a Survey made for Joseph Hopkins on order N<sup>o</sup> 2653 dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February 1767. This tract interferes two hundred and eleven acres with the John Correy Survey. - Joseph Hopkins conveyed to Samuel Wallace who conveyed to Daniel Ulerich, who conveyed to Stephen Miricle & John Feeter & Joel Graybill. John Feeter conveyed to John Mock the present owner. Stephen Miricle conveyed to M<sup>r</sup> Graybill whose widow & heirs now own the same.
