



Situate in Union Township Union County Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> day of November 1832. by virtue of an order of Survey granted to John Coxe, Jr. Dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1766. N<sup>o</sup> 52. Containing one hundred & ninety eight acres & ninety perches with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>er</sup> Cent & c.

Note. The same is part of a Larger tract of 300<sup>a.</sup> of land Surveyed for William Cook in pursuance of his order dated 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2079. And now owned and occupied by Samuel Templeton in Right of the Said William Cook.
