



The Part marked *A.* is an interference of 58<sup>a</sup> 20 ps. neat measure (part of a larger Tract) granted by Patent dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 1805 - to John Kuhn, now owned by Joseph Kepner Esq<sup>re</sup>.

Part marked *B.* Contains 45<sup>a</sup> 141 ps. and allowance. Now owned and Occupied by John Grimm jr. son of John Grimm the applicant, and appears not to be as yet patented.
