The purple Lines, represent the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for John Proctor, on Order N^o 328, dated 1st day of August 1766. This tract interferes Two hundred and Nineteen Acres and Seventy Seven perches with the Jacob Morgan Jr. Survey - John Proctor conveyed to William Trent - conveyed to Simon Gratz who conveyed to James Smith who devised to James Smith the present owner.
