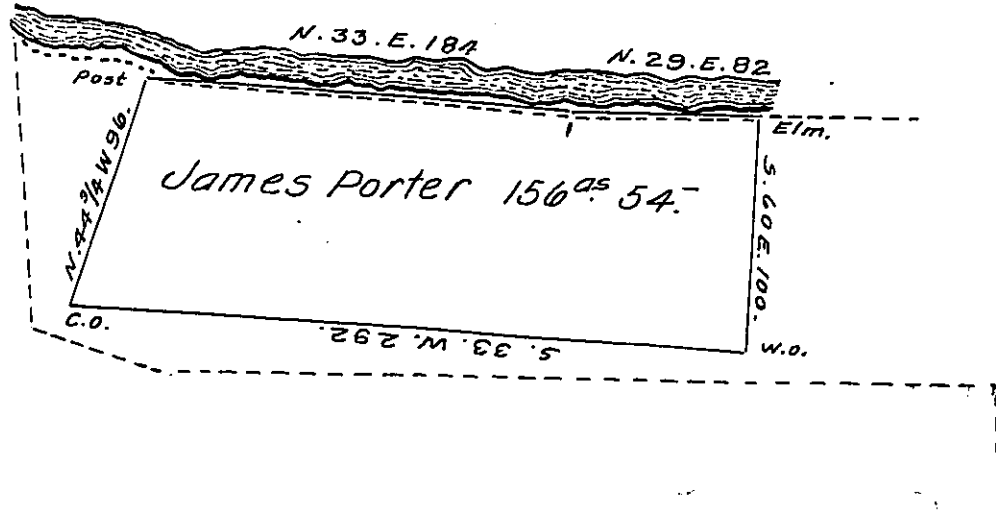


Robt Porter

In Frankstown township Huntingdon County containing One hundred and fifty Six acres and fifty four perches and allowance of Six per Cent. Surveyed for James Porter on order N^o 867 dated the 16th day of August 1766.
