This tract Interferes one Hundred and Sixteen acres and Ninety Eight perches with the James Dunlop tract - Adam Burthnot conveyed to Jacob Eyster, who also purchased from Samuel Riddle Esq^r who had purchased from the Widow of Samuel Perry who purchased from James Dunlop. Jacob Eyster conveyed to Jonathan Hendrixon who devised the same to Campbell Hendrixon the present owner.

N^o 1. represents part of the draught of a tract of land Surveyed for Michal Murphey on Warrant dated the 18th February 1786. this tract interferes Eleven acres and twenty five perches with the James Dunlop tract - Michal Murphey conveyed to Paul Sees, who conveyed to John Cruse the present owner.
