



Application No 725-4th Aug^t 1766. to Philip Working for 100^{ac} in Manheim Township.

The above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 104^{ac} 40^{ps}. Surveyed by Moses McLean D.S. on Warrant to Charles Warner dated August 6th 1787. and is the same Land formerly applied for by Philip Working-Situate in Manheim Township-Charles Warner the above Warrantee had it surveyed, and after him his son Charles Warner owned, and I am told yet owns it. He however some years ago abandoned it and removed to the West. He sold a part to one Baublitz before his removal-The remainder lies I believe in a State of Waste. - Witness my hand.
