



Situate on the South Side of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta - opposite the mouth of Coffee Run in Hopewell township Huntingdon County. Containing two hundred and fifteen and one half acres and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads - Surveyed for John Welsh on order N<sup>o</sup> 631 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1766 -
