 for Andrew West on warrant dated the 7th day of March 1794. This tract interferes Forty
 three acres and one hundred perches with the John Brady Survey - Andrew West con-
 veyed to Thomas Ruston who conveyed to M^c Dubois, who conveyed to Cannon &
 Stewart. who conveyed to Thomas Jackson who sold to Henry Spong
 the present owner.
