The dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for William Johnston on Warrant dated the 11th day of February 1793. This tract interferes Sixty four Acres and thirty four perches with the William Wicoff Jr. Survey. William Johnston conveyed to George Runq the present owner. The green lines represent the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for Peter Shoenberger on Warrant dated the 11th day of December 1793- this Survey Interferes Eighty Seven acres and one hundred and twenty two perches with the William Wicoff Jr. Survey. Peter Shoenberger conveyed to George Shoenberger who conveyed to Dr. Peter Shoenberger the present owner.
