



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks.) County Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to William Mansfield dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 511. Containing two hundred & thirty three Acres & 59 perches with the usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same with an adjoining body of land containing - Acres was Surveyed the - day of February 1769 for James Bremner in pursuance of a Special grant to him Dated &c. And now owned & Occupied by Jonah & George Gephart in right of the said James Bremner.
