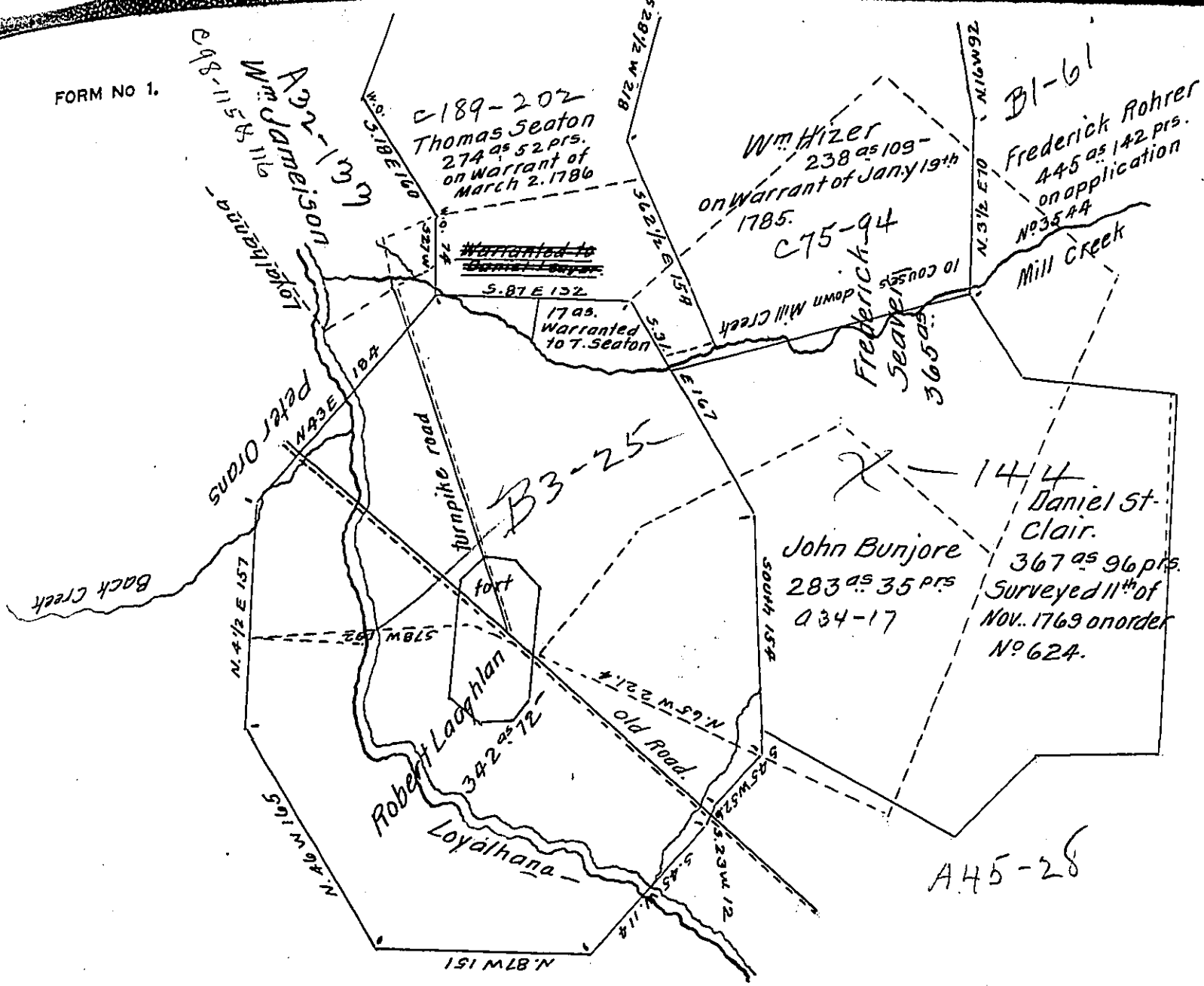

No. 1. The above diagram was surveyed unto Gen. St Clair by virtue of a grant or Charter from Gen. Gage while Commander of his Majesties troops in America to Arthur St. Clair then Capt<sup>n</sup> and Commanding at Fort Ligonier, and now belongs to the Westmoreland bank of Pennsylvania and contains 734<sup>as</sup> &c.

Note) the above drgfts viz. (F. Rohrer and <sup>H.</sup> Slaughter) in Rohrer's name, Wm Hizer and Daniel St. Clair had all been made on different scales from the town tract and so many <sup>would</sup> courses that it <sup>would</sup> have been almost impossible to protract and connect them accurately and it is thought that the above would be sufficiently satisfactory as those lands have all been Warranted and some spots two or three times.
