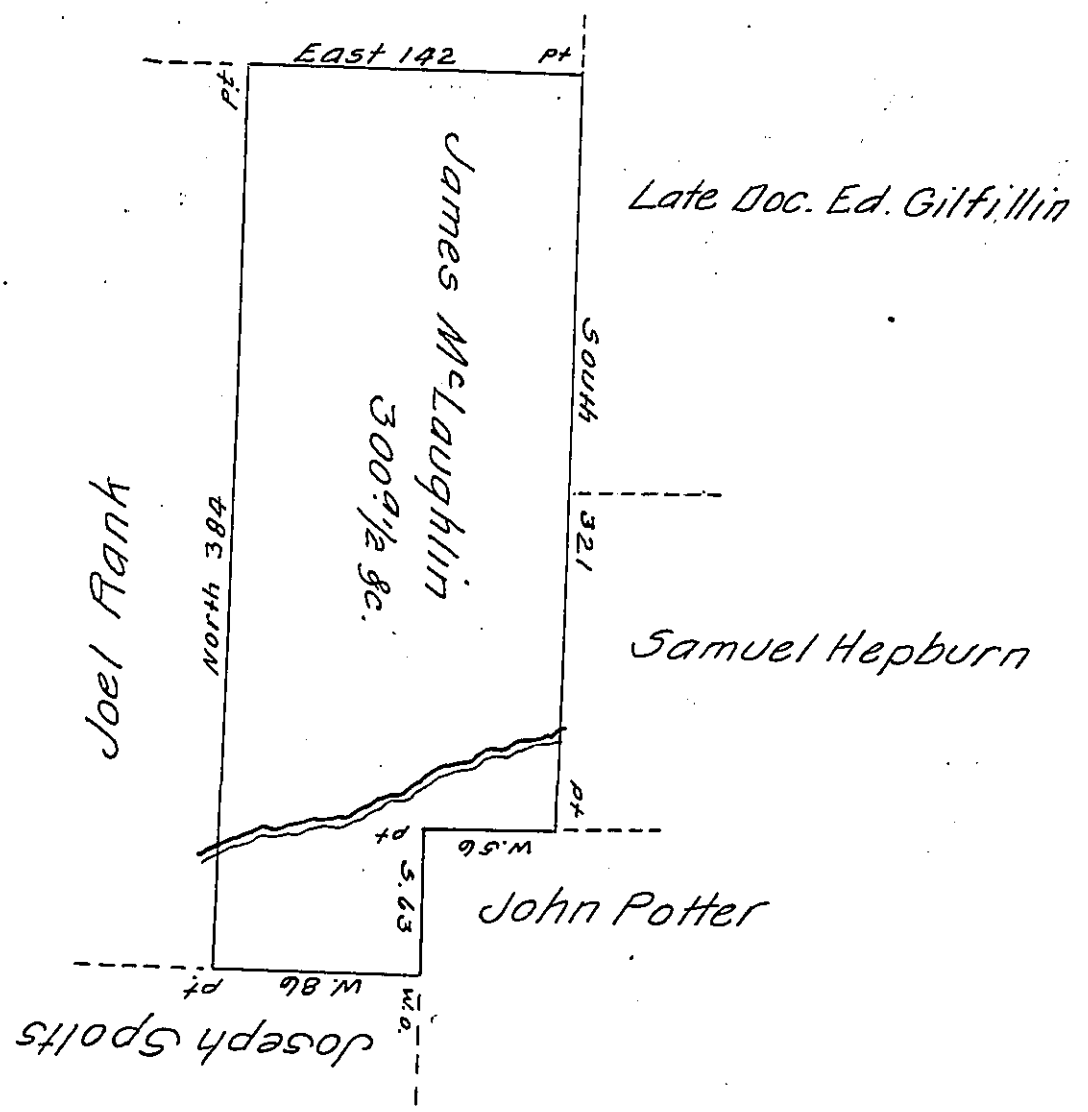


Dan. Caldwell Esq



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 2^d day of September 1834 by virtue of an Order granted to James McLaughlin dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. 2228. Containing three hundred Acres and Eighty four perches with the Usual Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c.

Note. The above mentioned tract of land was Surveyed the — day of — 1769 for Joseph Frazier in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1768. N. — And now owned and Occupied by John Rank in right of the said Joseph Frazier.
