



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks.) County. Surveyed the 4th day of November 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to James Simpson dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N. 824 Containing two hundred & forty four Acres - with the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent &c.

Note. The Same tract of land was Surveyed the 18th day of April - for Japheth Morton in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. 3721 - And now owned and Occupied by Thomas McGuire in right of the Said Japheth Morton - After a lengthy law suit.
