



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed App: No. 4277, issued 10<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1767, to John Oblens for 100<sup>ac</sup> in Berwick Township, on big Corowago-, on Lands situate now in Reading Township, Adams County, on big Corowago-, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
