



A draft of a tract of land situate in a cove of Terrass Mountain, in Friend's Cove, Colerain township, Bedford County, Containing one hundred & fifty one Acres, and one hundred & three perches & allowance of six per Cent for Floods, &c. Surveyed in pursuance of an Order granted to George Flemming, No. 4351, dated the 2nd day of September, 1767.

The dotted lines represent a draft of a tract of land surveyed the 3rd day of June, 1788, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Patrick Heany dated the 22nd day of November, 1787. This tract interferes with the George Flemming tract one hundred & forty seven Acres & 118 perches, George Flemming conveyed this land to John Dodrige who conveyed the same to Anchor Worley who conveyed the same to Patrick Heany who obtained the aforesaid Warrant, Patrick Heany's heirs, conveyed the same to Patrick Heany the present owner of the whole tract.
