The line trees in the above Survey are different on all Actual Survey the several lines thereof on the Eastern Side the Present Owner oldest line trees shew a line made in 1755 on some Abraham Fertig Esq others the line is apparently made in 1762 the informant who resides near the land on it is only some cleared land No Draught to shew the date of the original Survey.
