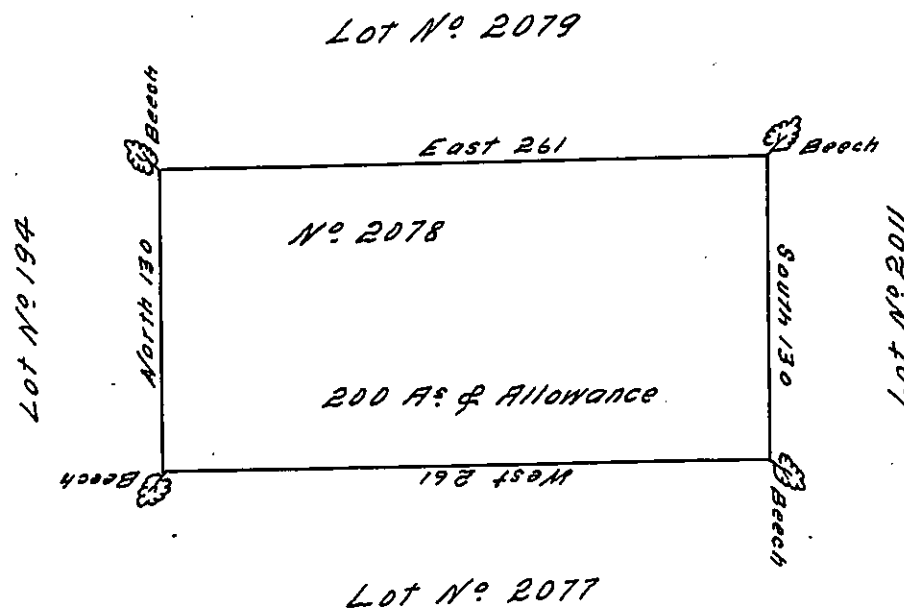

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly
 of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24 day of August 1785
 entitled "An act for directing the mode of distributing the donation
 lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth." And by order of
 the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble Executive
 Council, I have surveyed on the 5th day of August 1785 the above
 described tract of two hundred acres and allowance of six P.Ct.
 for roads &c. No. MMLXXVIII. situate in district No. 10 on the West side
 of Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland.
