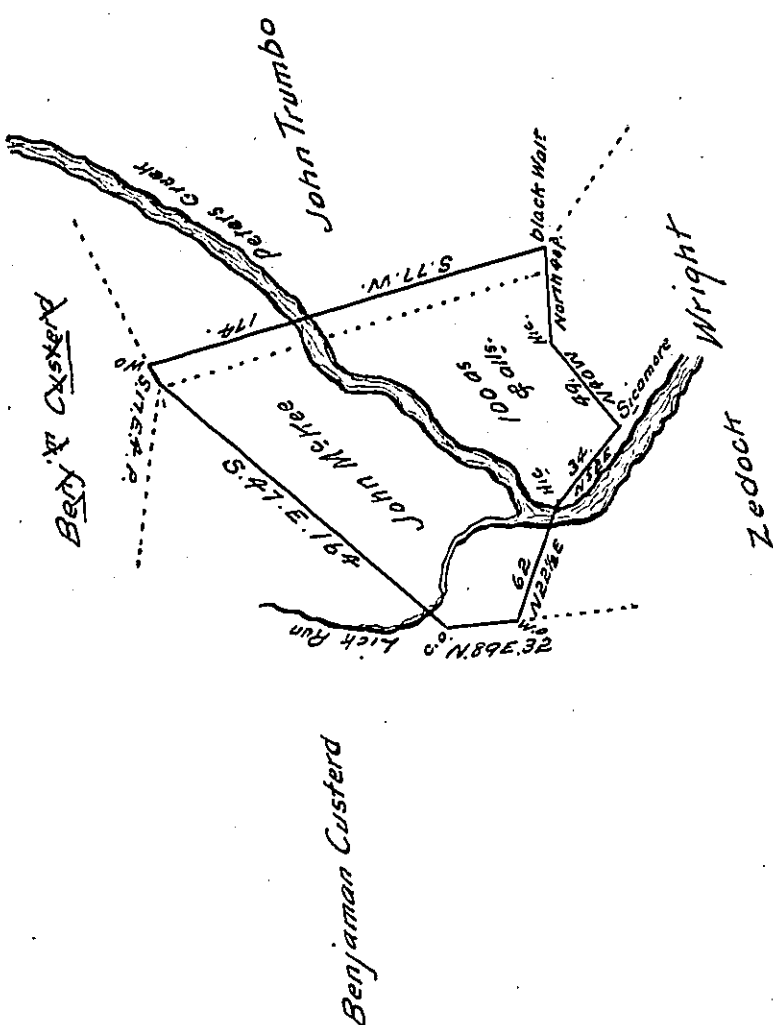

 in the name of James Clark calling for 100 ac<sup>s</sup> title of Clark in John  
 Trumbo & He has a mill Erected thereon - J. Clark Pat.
