



A Draft of a tract of Land situate on the North West side of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta in the first bend above the old Crossings of said River in Providence Township Bedford County - containing Eleven Acres and one Hundred perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. - Surveyed for James Martin on Warrant dated the 30th day of September 1774 -

George Enslow conveyed to James Martin from ^{whom} it was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County to David Beckwith who conveyed to Benjamin Wallace who conveyed to Henry Woods & Dr. John Anderson who conveyed to Hugh Denningson who devised the same to his widow and Heirs the present owners.
