in the name of James Rankin; one of 17th January 1772 for 200^{as} the other of 15 July 1773 for 100^{as} Situate in Bullskin township Fayette County and now returned on 5^d two rights by virtue of contract with the Board of Property there is a small interfer. at A where about 12^{as} was taken by Warrant of Isaac & John White the remainder on the John Cumpton Order N^o 125 of 3^d Ap (obl) dated 24 Sep^r 1785 was patented to Mary Hite, Cathrine Hite & Sarah Hite 20 Dec^r 1797 and is now owned by Thomas Atkinson (or Acheson) on the premises, cannot learn as any supposed survey was ever made on the Rankin Warrants
