



Application 4879 - 26th March 1768 for 300^{ac} including his impt
 made in 1763 in Manoham or Huntingdon town^{sh} to Ebenezer Horseman -

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the re-
 covery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth
 from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other
 office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government
 and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed
 appⁿ 4879 - granted 26th March 1768, to Ebenezer Horseman
 for 300^{ac} as above specified on lands situate as aforesaid in
 Huntingdon township and have found the interferences as re-
 presented in the enclosed diagram. - Witness my hand.
