No 1 represented by dotted lines is part of the draught of a survey made for Joseph Skippen, on order No 1 dated the 1st day of August 1766. This tract interferes two hundred and twenty and three fourths acres with the James Barrett Survey, Joseph Skippen, devised the same to Henry Skippen who conveyed to Josiah Elsasser and Andrew M^EFarland the present owners.

No 2. represented by dotted lines is part of a survey made
for Joshua Burley an warrant dated the 21st day of May 1793.
this survey interferes thirty six and one half acres with
the James Barrett tract. Joshua Burley conveyed to James
E. Stewart the present owner.
