



Situate in Fawn township in the County of York containing as above set forth 75^{ac} 149 perches & the usual allowance &c. Located on the 8th day of June 1831. In pursuance of John Sinkler's application No 4924 for 100^{ac} dated the 11th of April 1768 and by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property. Report. The above is wholly the same land as that which William Mathews late D.S. surveyed and returned for Isaac Anderson in pursuance of a warrant for 50^{ac} dated the 21st of June 1764 and in the year 1771 Mathews surveyed it again for Robert Stevenson in pursuance of a warrant in the name of John Stuart for 50^{ac} dated the 19th February 1763. Now owned and occupied by Anthony Jones & William Torbet.
