Report- This land is wholly covered by a survey of 221 1/2 1/2 made and returned by William Mathews for Joshua Brown on a warrant for 200 1/2, dated the 25th day of January 1770 agreeably to the Judgement of the Board of Property. Now owned & occupied by the Widow & Joshua Oliver. The dotted lines represent the balance of Browns survey.
