



Situate in Paradise township in the County of York contain-  
 ing as above set forth 109 5/8 57 1/2 perches and allowance 100. Being  
 part of a larger tract of land which was originally in pur-  
 suance of Henry Lukebaugh's application No 4842, dated the  
 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1768. Resurveyed and divided off from
