



In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other purposes. I have this day located and surveyed app' no 4785 issued 2<sup>d</sup> March 1768 to Joseph Young, for 200 a. in Manheim township, on lands situate formerly in Manheim, now in Mount Pleasant township, Adams County, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
