recovery of the principal and interest due to the Common-
wealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or
other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary
Government and for other purposes I have this day located
and surveyed ~~warrant~~ application No. 4841 granted 12th March
1768, to Robert Park for 150 a. as above specified on lands situ-
ate as aforesaid and have found the interferences as repre-
sented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
