The above tract is wholly covered by a survey of 64th 26th made 15 May 1784, on a warrant to Arthur Clark dated 22nd April 1776 & claimed under said title.

From information received Alexander McKnitt one claimed the above land and sold his right to Arthur Clarke; who afterwards took a warrant for the same. No evidence of survey on McKnitts warrant or of any person now claiming under the same.
