(On an application granted for 150 a. of land on the head of Antetem Creek joining Anne Stacey John Hess & the South Mountain in Anttrim township dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of January 1768 No 470.) In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights.
