

The above tract is covered by the following office rights to wit. The part marked A. of 77 acres 162 perches & al. is included in a survey of 270 A. 148 P<sup>s</sup> on an order of survey to Stephen Duncan dated 13<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1766 No 2168 & held under said title. The dotted figure C represents the balance of survey on Duncan's order.

The part of the tract marked B. is included within the lines of a larger tract of 244 acres surv'd on a warrant to Griffith Jones dated 14<sup>th</sup> December 1785 and held under said title.

Note. The part A owned & occupied by Peter Stake, and the part B owned and occupied by W<sup>m</sup> Emery's heirs and James Kilgore.  
N.B. No evidence of possession in McMurray or any person claiming under his location.
