



Situate in Godorus township in the County of York containing as above set forth 26<sup>95</sup> 49 perches and the usual allowance. Surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1831 in pursuance of Paul Schleasmans application No 4618 for 50<sup>95</sup> dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November 1767 and by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property

This is the same land which was originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Isler dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1753 and afterwards resurveyed and returned and a piece of vacancy added by Jacob Spangler on the 10<sup>th</sup> November 1809 in pursuance of said warrant and is now said to be patented owned and occupied by John Behler.
