



Situate in Tybaine township Perry County containing one hundred and twenty acres 112 ac & allowance of six per cent for roads &c Resurveyed April 24<sup>th</sup> 1828 in pursuance of an order granted John Leech for 50 ac dated December 31<sup>st</sup> 1767 No 4671.
