


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Washington township (formerly Anttrim township) Franklin County containing one hundred & one acres, one hundred & twenty six perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c Surveyed the 28th of October 1829 (on a warrant granted Francis Oury for 100 $\frac{9}{16}$ of land joining William Means & Adam Cook, in Anttrim township dated the 10th of June 1762) in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
