



Draught of a tract of Land situate in Letterkenny township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) containing two hundred and twenty five acres thirty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c Was resurveyed by Matthew Henderson, formerly D. Surveyor, the 3^d of June 1771, for which a warrant had been granted to Richard Peters, Junr for 200 acres, "joining widow" Boyd, William Peebles, another widow Boyd & Jeremiah Belvin, in Letterkenny township, bearing date the 29 September, 1774. Examined and returned in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c.
