


FORM NO 1.



Draught of two hundred and six acres & eighty two perches of land, with the allowance of six per ct - situate in Turbet township, Mifflin County. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to John Patton & wife for two hundred acres, dated the 15th. March, 1765. Present owner & occupier Robert Patton, Esq^r Surveyed June 3^d 1828.

Note. A warrant was taken out by John Patton for the same land, dated the 26th. Augt 1785 for 250 95 which was laid off the above also included what is represented by the dotted lines.
