 vey of 431 acres made 22<sup>d</sup> February 1785 on warrant granted to  
 Samuel Reed, bearing date the 18 January 1785 & confirmed by patent  
 20 Dec<sup>r</sup> 1785 to said Reed who desired title under James Patterson,  
 the above land also recognized as that of James Patterson, in the  
 year 1763 by adjoining surveys.

Owned and occupied in part by Henry Brim, and part by John  
 Poorman and Martin Snyder, under the title founded on Reed's war-  
 rant aforesaid W. S. Davis
