


**FORM NO 1.**

Huntingdon County, containing sixty four acres and seventy one  
perches and allowance of six per cent. Surveyed agreeably  
to old marked lines the 9th day of December 1830 for Andrew  
Stell on warrant dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1763.
