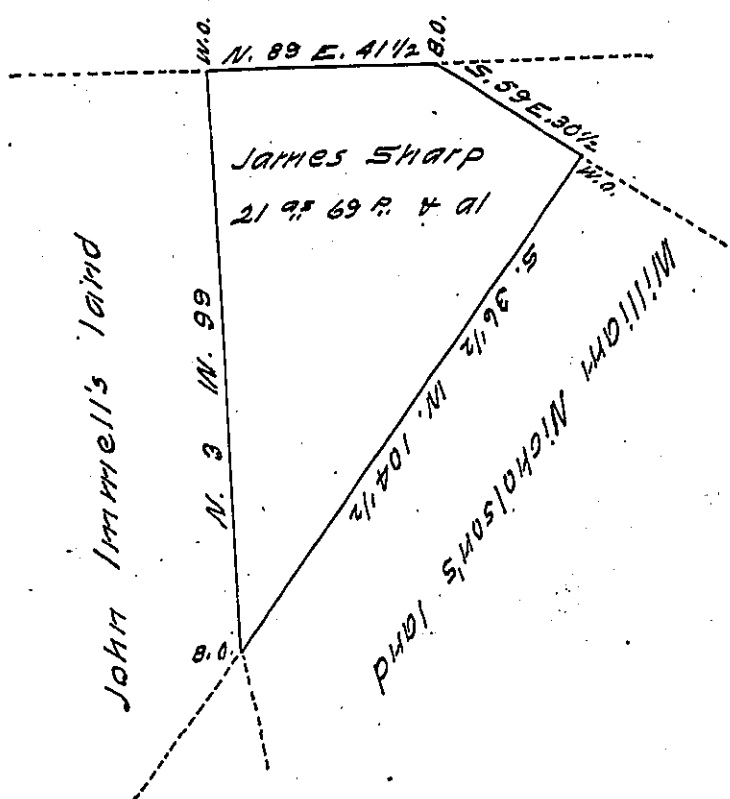


Formerly George Reynolds
